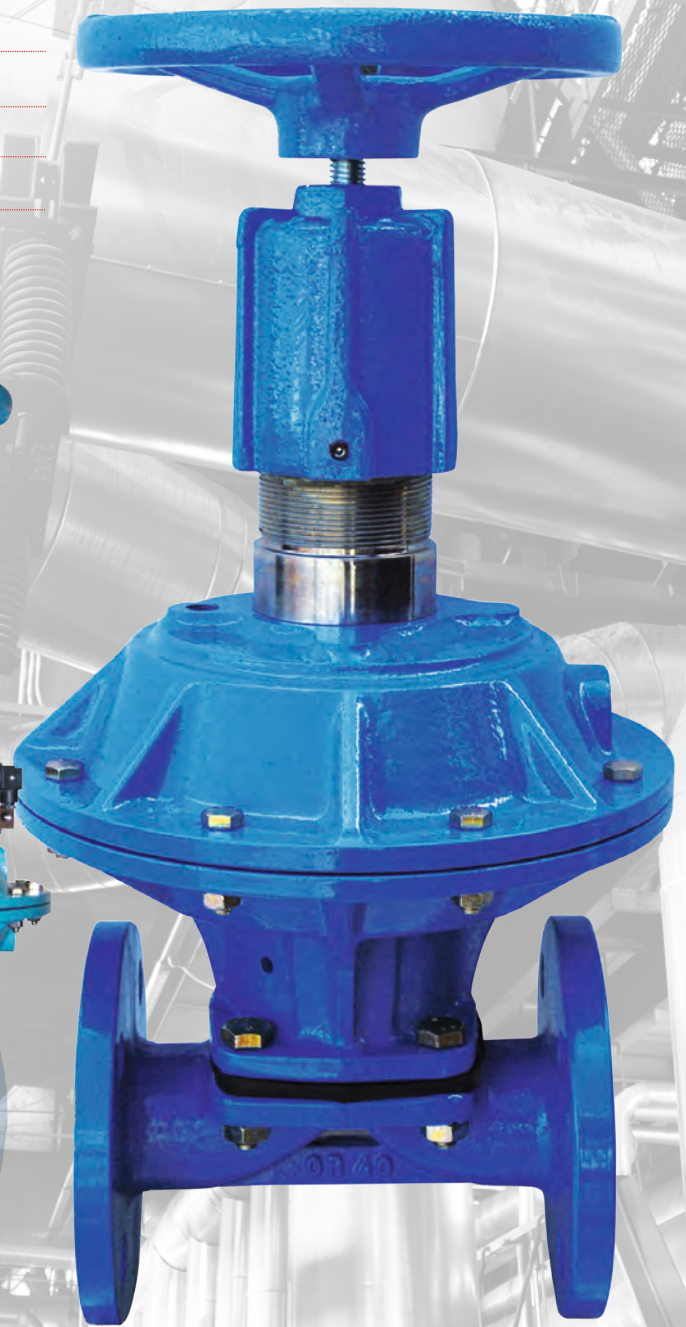

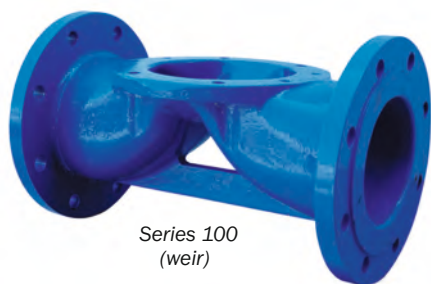

DIAPHRAGM BODY DESIGN

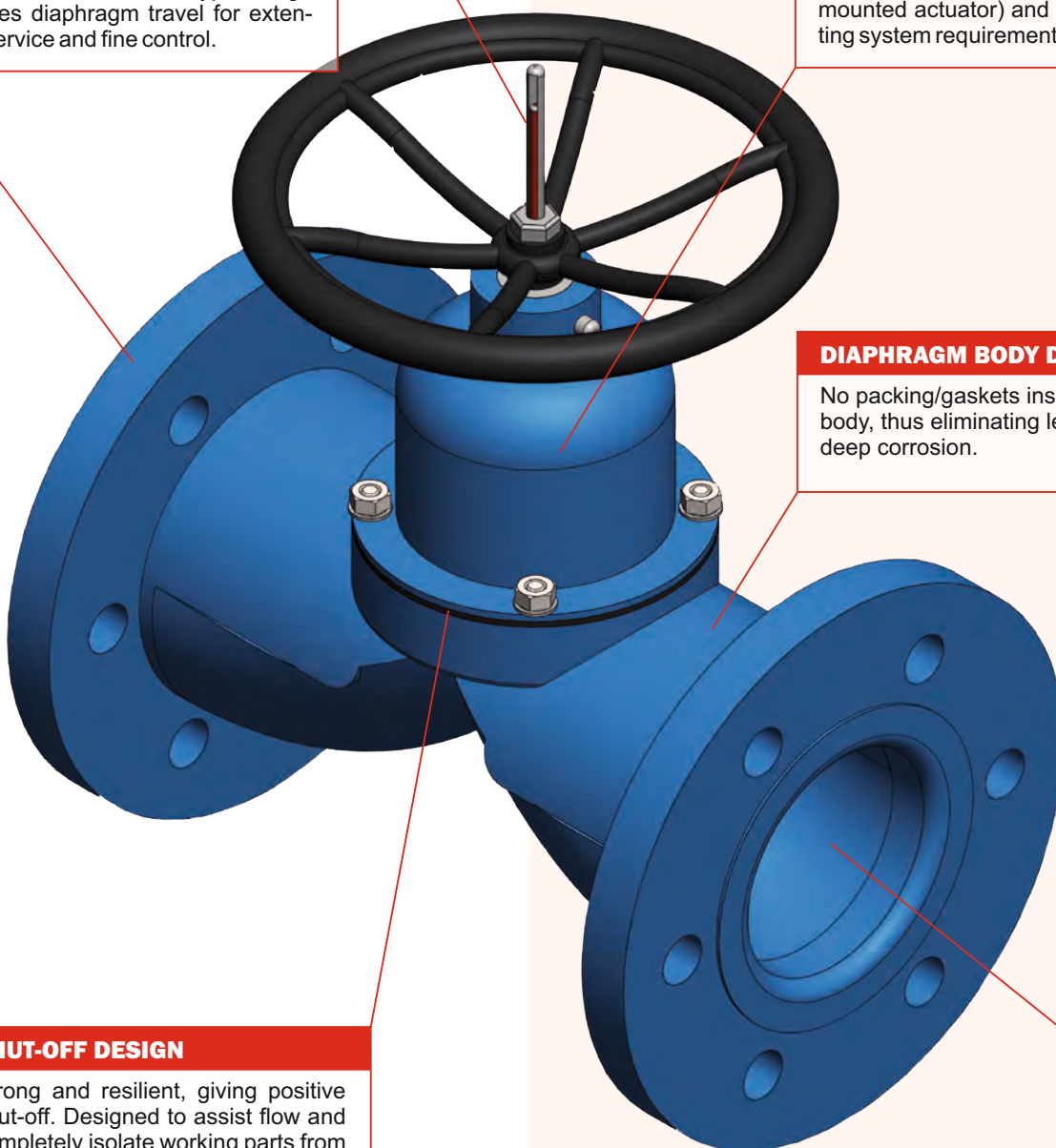
No packing/gaskets inside the valve body, thus eliminating leak path and deep corrosion.
